➤ Question # 2: Community Street Lighting Project

The North Fork Infrastructure Committee is in the process of evaluating replacing all of the current street lights within the community, which are original (approx. 30 years old) and showing signs of significant wear-and tear. Funds have been allocated in the POA's capital plan, based on the 2018 Reserve Study, to pay for this capital improvement (with no new additional assessments required). The committee has received a few unsolicited inquiries from homeowners about the possibility of increasing the uniformity of lighting within the community to help address poorly lit areas, as there are presently a limited number of street lights inside the gates and they are spaced relatively far apart.

A. Which one would you prefer (please select one box only):

- Replace only the existing street lights inside and outside the gates (i.e., no increase in the number of street lights).
- Add new street lights to increase the uniformity of lighting along the streets and in the cul-de-sacs inside the gates within the community.
